## **4 GUIDELINES:**

circle compost

## MOISTURE CHECK!

1. QUALITY (use a mix of many ingredients)

- Grab a handful of compost and squeeze, is there?
- 2. VOLUME (more than 1m³)
- a) Lots of dripping moisture? = Too wet.
- 3. MOISTURE (keep damp like a rung sponge!)
- b) Beads of moisture= Perfect!
- 4. CIRCULATION (turn it or poke it full of holes. The more you turn it the hotter / faster it will break down.)
- c) No moisture at all?= Too dry.

TIP: Get water right into the middle of your compost.
